Summary and Highlights

Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and Uttar Pradesh Election Watch (UPEW) have analysed the last 15 years of elections in Uttar Pradesh, both parliamentary and Assembly Elections. For this analysis, ADR has included the parliamentary elections in 2004, 2009 and 2014; and assembly elections in 2007, 2012 and 2017. Following are the highlights that emerge from the analysis:-

- <u>Total number of candidates analysed</u>: A total of 19971 candidates who have contested either in the Parliamentary or State assembly elections since 2004 from Uttar Pradesh have been analyzed by ADR and UPEW.
- <u>Total number of MPs/MLAs analysed</u>: A total of 1443 MPs/MLAs who have held seats either in the Parliamentary or State assembly elections since 2004 from Uttar Pradesh have been analyzed by ADR and UPEW.

Criminal Background:

- <u>Candidates with criminal cases</u>: A total of **3432(17%)** out of these 19971 candidates have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- **Candidates with serious criminal cases:** 2047 (10%) out of the 19971 candidates analyzed have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.
- <u>MPs/MLAs with criminal cases</u>: Out of 1443 MPs/MLAs analyzed since 2004, 546(38%) have declared criminal cases against themselves. 328 (23%) have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.
- Party wise candidates who have declared criminal cases: 426(32%) out of 1323 candidates who have contested from BJP since 2004 have declared criminal cases against themselves. 292 (28%) out of 1043 candidates who have contested from INC, 491 (35%) out of 1403 BSP candidates, 511 (40%) out of 1286 SP candidates, and 114 (19%) out of 588 RLD candidates have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- Party wise candidates who have declared serious criminal cases: 237(18%) out of 1323 candidates who have contested from BJP since 2004 have declared serious criminal cases against themselves. 148 (14%) out of 1043 candidates who have contested from INC, 311 (22%) out of



1403 **BSP** candidates, **296 (23%)** out of 1286 **SP** candidates, and 80 **(14%)** out of 588 **RLD** candidates have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.

- Party wise MPs/ MLAs with criminal cases: Out of 354 MPs/ MLAs from BSP, 120(34%) have declared criminal cases against themselves. 180(37%) out 486 MPs/MLAs from BJP, 179(42%) out of 430 MPs/MLAs from SP, 31(35%) out of 89 MPs/MLAs from INC, and 6(21%) out 28 MPs / MLAs from RLD have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- Party wise MPs/MLAs with serious criminal cases: Out of 354 MPs/ MLAs from BSP, 68(19%) have declared serious criminal cases against themselves. 124(25%) out 486 MPs/MLAs from BJP, 92(21%) out of 430 MPs/MLAs from SP, 17(19%) out of 89 MPs/MLAs from INC, and 4(14%) out 28 MPs / MLAs from RLD have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.

Financial Background:

- Crorepati Candidates: A total of 3936(20%) out of these 19971 candidates analysed since 2004, were crorepatis.
- Crorepati MPs/MLAs: Out of 1443 MPs/MLAs analyzed since 2004, 864(60%) were crorepati.
- Party wise Crorepati Candidates: 827(59%) out of 1403 BSP candidates analysed were crorepati, 686 (52%) out of 1323 candidates analysed from BJP, 438 (42%) out of 1043 INC candidates analysed, 707 (55%) out of 1286 SP candidates analysed and 171(29%) out of 588 RLD candidates were crorepati.
- Party wise Crorepati MPs/MLAs: Out of 430 MPs/MLAs from SP, 248 (58%) were crorepati.
 152(43%) out 354 MPs/MLAs from BSP, 356(73%) out of 486 MPs/MLAs from BJP, 52(58%) out of 89 MPs/MLAs from INC and 18(64%) out 28 MPs/MLAs from RLD were crorepati.

Gender Analysis

- <u>Women candidates:</u> Out of the 19971 candidates analyzed, only **1484 (7%)** are women.
- Women MPs/MLAs: Out of the 1443 MPs/MLAs analyzed, only 131 (9%) are women.





Uttar Pradesh Assembly Elections (2007-2019)

ADR and Uttar Pradesh election watch have analysed 16668 candidates who contested and 1208 MLAs elected for the Uttar Pradesh Assembly Elections, 2007, 2012 and 2017.

Criminal Background

- **Candidates with declared criminal cases:** A total of **2893(17%)** out of these 16668 candidates analysed have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- **Candidates with declared serious criminal cases: 1637 (10%)** out of the 16668 candidates analyzed have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.
- <u>MLAs with declared criminal cases</u>: Out of 1208 MLAs analyzed since 2007, 463(38%) have declared criminal cases against themselves. 270 (22%) have declared serious criminal cases against themselves




Figure: Candidates and MLAs with Declared Criminal Cases in Uttar Pradesh Assembly Elections: 2007, 2012 and 2017




Figure: Party Wise Candidates with Declared Criminal Cases in Uttar Pradesh Assembly Elections: 2007, 2012 and 2017

- <u>Party wise candidates who have declared criminal cases:</u> 404(34%) out of 1175 BSP candidates analysed since 2007 Assembly elections have declared criminal cases against themselves. 360 (33%) out of 1104 candidates analysed from BJP, 240 (29%) out of 840 INC candidates analysed, 418 (39%) out of 1074 SP candidates analysed and 109(19%) out of 564 RLD candidates have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- Party wise candidates who have declared serious criminal cases: 247(21%) out of 1175 BSP candidates analysed since 2007 Assembly elections have declared serious criminal cases against themselves. 186 (17%) out of 1104 candidates analysed from BJP, 114 (13%) out of 840 INC candidates analysed, 223 (21%) out of 1074 SP candidates analysed and 77(13%) out of 564 RLD candidates have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.




Figure: Party Wise MLAs with Declared Cases in Uttar Pradesh Assembly Elections – 2007, 2012 and 2017





- Party wise MLAs with criminal cases: Out of 367 MLAs from SP, 158 (43%) have declared criminal cases against themselves. 106(34%) out 315 MLAs from BSP, 149(37%) out of 400 MLAs from BJP, 22(39%) out of 57 MLAs from INC and 4(21%) out 19 MLAs from RLD have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- Party wise MLAs with serious criminal cases: Out of 367 MLAs from SP, 79 (22%) have declared serious criminal cases against themselves. 56(18%) out 315 MLAs from BSP, 98(25%) out of 400 MLAs from BJP, 13(23%) out of 57 MLAs from INC and 3(16%) out 19 MLAs from RLD have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.

Financial Background

- <u>Crorepati Candidates</u>: A total of **3211(19%)** out of these 16668 candidates analysed since 2007, were crorepatis.
- Crorepati MLAs: Out of 1208 MLAs analyzed since 2007, 718(59%) were crorepati.




Figure: Crorepati Candidates and MLAs in Uttar Pradesh Assembly Elections - 2007, 2012, and 2017

Party wise Crorepati Candidates: 693(59%) out of 1175 BSP candidates analysed were crorepati. 561 (51%) out of 1104 candidates analysed from BJP, 319 (38%) out of 840 INC candidates analysed, 581 (54%) out of 1074 SP candidates analysed and 156(28%) out of 564
 RLD candidates were crorepati.








Figure: Party Wise Crorepati Candidates in Uttar Pradesh Assembly Elections – 2007, 2012 and 2017

Party wise Crorepati MLAs: Out of 367 MLAs from SP, 218 (59%) were crorepati. 135(43%) out 315 MLAs from BSP, 289(72%) out of 400 MLAs from BJP, 31(54%) out of 57 MLAs from INC and 11(58%) out 19 MLAs from RLD were crorepati.




Figure: Party Wise Crorepati MLAs in Uttar Pradesh Assembly Elections - 2007, 2012 and 2017

- Average assets of candidates who have contested elections: The average assets of 16668 candidates analyzed since 2007 is **Rs.1.14 crores.**
- Average assets of MLAs: The average assets of 1208 MLAs analyzed since 2007 is Rs.3.44 crores.








Figure: Average Assets of Candidates and MLAs in Uttar Pradesh Assembly Elections - 2007, 2012, and 2017

Assets increase – Re- elected MLAs in Uttar Pradesh Assembly Elections

- <u>Re-elected MLAs:</u> Uttar Pradesh Election Watch (UPEW) and Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analyzed the affidavits of **31** re-elected MLAs in the Uttar Pradesh Assembly elections in 2007, 2012 and 2017 (Including Bye- Elections).
- <u>Average Assets in 2007 Elections</u>: The average assets of these 31 re-elected MLAs from various parties including independent MLAs in 2007 was **Rs 1.24 crores** (Rs 1,24,30,212).
- Average Assets in 2012 Elections: The average assets of these 31 re-elected MLAs in 2012 is Rs
 3.78 crores (Rs.3,78,37,928).
- <u>Average Assets in 2017 Elections</u>: The average assets of these 31 re-elected MLAs in 2017 is Rs
 7.74 crores (Rs.7,74,77,691).
- Average Asset change from 2007 to 2017: The average assets of these 31 re- elected MLAs, between the Uttar Pradesh Elections of 2007 and 2017 has increased by Rs. 6.50 crores (Rs. 6,50,47,479).
- Percentage change in assets from 2007 to 2017: The average percentage increase in assets for these 31 re-elected MLAs is 523%.

- Women MLAs: Out of 1208 MLAs analysed, only 98 (8%) were women.




Figure: Women Candidates and MLAs in Uttar Pradesh Assembly Elections - 2007, 2012 and 2017





Lok Sabha Elections – Uttar Pradesh (2004 - 2019)

ADR and Uttar Pradesh election watch have analysed 3303 candidates who contested and 235 MPs for the Uttar Pradesh Lok Sabha Elections, 2004, 2009 and 2014.

Criminal Background

- **Candidates with declared criminal cases:** A total of **539(16%)** out of these 3303 candidates analysed have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- <u>Candidates with declared serious criminal cases</u>: 410 (12%) out of the 3303 candidates analyzed have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.
- <u>MPs with declared criminal cases</u>: Out of 235 MPs analyzed since 2004, 80(34%) have declared criminal cases against themselves. 58 (25%) have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.




Figure: Candidates and MPs with Declared Criminal Cases in Uttar Pradesh Lok Sabha Elections: 2004, 2009 and 2014

Party wise candidates who have declared criminal cases: 87(38%) out of 228 BSP candidates analysed since 2004 Lok Sabha election in Uttar Pradesh have declared criminal cases against themselves. 66 (30%) out of 219 candidates analysed from BJP, 52 (26%) out of 202 INC candidates analysed, 93 (44%) out of 212 SP candidates analysed and 5(21%) out of 24 RLD candidates have declared criminal cases against themselves.




Figure: Party Wise Candidates with Declared Criminal Cases in Uttar Pradesh Lok Sabha Elections: 2004, 2009 and 2014

- Party wise candidates who have declared serious criminal cases: 64(28%) out of 228 BSP candidates analysed since 2004 Lok Sabha election in Uttar Pradesh have declared serious criminal cases against themselves. 51 (23%) out of 219 candidates analysed from BJP, 34(16%) out of 209 INC candidates analysed, 73 (34%) out of 212 SP candidates analysed and 3(12%) out of 24 RLD candidates have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.
- Party wise MPs with criminal cases: Out of 39 MPs from BSP, 14 (36%) have declared criminal cases against themselves. 31(36%) out 86 MPs from BJP, 9(28%) out of 32 MPs from INC, 21(33%) out of 63 MPs from SP, 2(22%) out 9 MPs from RLD have declared criminal cases against themselves.








Party wise MPs with serious criminal cases: Out of 39 MPs from BSP, 12 (31%) have declared serious criminal cases against themselves. 26(30%) out 86 MPs from BJP, 4(13%) out of 32 MPs from INC, 13(21%) out of 63 MPs from SP, 1(11%) out 9 MPs from RLD have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.

Financial Background

<u>Crorepati Candidates</u>: A total of 725(22%) out of these 3303 candidates analysed since 2004, were crorepatis.



• Crorepati MPs: Out of 235 MPs analyzed since 2004, 146(62%) were crorepati.

Party wise Crorepati Candidates: 134(59%) out of 228 BSP candidates analysed were crorepati.
 125 (57%) out of 219 candidates analysed from BJP, 119 (59%) out of 202 INC candidates analysed,
 126 (59%) out of 212 SP candidates analysed and 15(63%) out of 24 RLD candidates were crorepati.




Figure: Party Wise Crorepati Candidates in Uttar Pradesh Lok Sabha Elections- 2004, 2009 and 2014

Party wise Crorepati MPs: Out of 63 MPs from SP, 30 (48%) were crorepati. 17(44%) out 39 MPs from BSP, 67(78%) out of 86 MPs from BJP, 21(66%) out of 32 MPs from INC and 7(78%) out 9 MPs from RLD were crorepati.



- Average assets of MPs: The average assets of 235 MPs analyzed since 2004 is Rs.6.08 crores.








Figure: Average Assets of Candidates and MPs in Uttar Pradesh Lok Sabha Elections – 2004, 2009 and 2014

Assets increase – Re- elected MPs in Uttar Pradesh Lok Sabha Elections

- <u>Average Assets in 2004 Elections</u>: The average assets of these 5 re-elected MPs in 2004 was Rs
 2.56 crores (Rs 2,56,44,463).
- <u>Average Assets in 2009 Elections</u>: The average assets of these 5 re-elected MPs in 2009 is Rs 5.91 crores (Rs. 5,91,68,029).
- Average Assets in 2014 Elections: The average assets of these 5 re-elected MPs in 2014 is Rs 15.64 crores (Rs 15,64,80,594)
- <u>Average Asset change from 2004 to 2014</u>: The average assets of these 5 re- elected MPs, between the Uttar Pradesh Lok Sabha Elections of 2004 and 2014 has increased by Rs. 13.08 crores (Rs. 13,08,36,131).
- Percentage change in assets from 2004 to 2014: The average percentage increase in assets for these 5 re-elected MPs is 510%.

- <u>Women MPs:</u> Out of 235 MPs analysed, only **33(14%)** were women.




Figure: Women Candidates and MPs in Uttar Pradesh Lok Sabha Elections - 2004, 2009 and 2014
