Analysis of Election Expenditure Statements of MLAs

Haryana Assembly Elections, 2019

According to Section 78 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, every contesting candidate has to lodge a true copy of his election expenses within 30 days from the date of declaration of result of election, with the District Election Officer in all States and Union Territories. Haryana Election Watch and Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analyzed 89 election expenditure statements submitted after the Haryana Assembly Election 2019 for newly elected MLAs. The election expenditure statement of 1 MLA namely Rakesh Janghu (Rakesh Daultabad) (Independent) from Badshahpur constituency was not analysed as his expenditure statements was not available on the website at the time of making this report. The expenditure limit for the MLAs during the Haryana Assembly elections was Rs. 28 lakhs. These election expense documents include details of expenses on public meetings and processions, campaigning through electronic and print media, expense on campaign workers, expense on vehicles used and expense on campaign materials.

Recommendations:

- Each Winner is required to file his election expenditure statement within 30 days of the results of the elections, the deadline in case of the Haryana Assembly Elections being the 23rd November 2019. However, it was observed that the election expenditure statements of the Winners were not uploaded on the CEO/DEO's website till significantly after the deadline. It is recommended that the Abstract Expenditure Statement (Annexure E2) of the MLAs is uploaded on the website of the CEO within 72 hours of the receipt of the statement.
- 2. The deadline for filing an election petition against any Winner is 45 days after the declaration of the results. Generally, MLAs submit their election expenditure statements towards the end of the 30 days given for submission of the statements. This leaves 15 days for any common citizen to file an election petition against any Winner. The deadline for filing an election petition should be increased in order to give the citizens time to scrutinize the election expenditure statements of the MLAs and gather the relevant documents/proof etc. for the election petition.
- 3. As has been instated in the filing of affidavits during the elections, the MLAs should not be allowed to keep any field blank on the Abstract Election Expenditure statement (Annexure E2) and Schedule 1 to 10. The statements must be filled in a legible format and overwriting of amounts in the statement should be discouraged.

Summary and Highlights of Election Expenses of MLAs from the Haryana Assembly 2019 Elections

- 1. Less than 50% of the Limit: Out of 89 MLAs analysed, 36 (40%) MLAs have declared election expenses of less than 50% of the expense limit in their constituency.
- 2. <u>Average Election Expenses</u>: Based on the election expense declarations of 89 MLAs from Haryana Assembly, the average amount of money spent by them in the elections is **Rs 15.60 lakhs, which is 56% of the expense limit**.
- Party-wise Average Election Expenses: The party wise average election expenses shows that the average spending for 40 MLAs from BJP is Rs. 18.43 lakhs (65.8% of the expense limit). For 31 MLAs from INC, the average election expenditure is Rs.13.75 lakhs (49.1% of the expense limit), the average election expenditure for 10 MLAs from Jannayak Janta Party is Rs.13.09 lakhs (46.8% of the expense limit) and 6 Independent MLAs have spent Rs. 8.61 lakhs (30.8% of the expense limit).




Figure 1: Party-wise Average Election Expenses (Rs.in lakhs)

- 6. <u>Expense on Public Meeting, Rally, and Processions with Star Campaigners</u>: Out of the 89 MLAs analyzed, 65 (73%) MLAs have declared that they have spent funds on public meetings, processions etc. with star campaigners and 24 (27%) MLAs have declared that they have not spent any funds on public meetings, processions etc. with star campaigners.
- 7. Expense on Public Meeting, Rally, and Processions without Star Campaigners: Out of the 89 MLAs analyzed, 76 (85%) MLAs have declared that they have spent funds on public meetings, processions etc. without star campaigners and 13 (15%) MLAs have declared that they have not spent any funds on public meetings, processions etc. without star campaigners.
- 8. <u>Expense on Campaigning through electronic/print media</u>: 68(76%) MLAs have declared that they have spent funds on campaigning through electronic/print media and 21 (24%) MLAs have declared that they have not spent any funds on campaigning through electronic/print media.
- 9. Expense on Campaign Workers: 60(67%) MLAs have declared that they have spent funds on campaign workers and 29 (33%) MLAs have declared that they have not spent any funds on campaign workers.
- 10. <u>Expense on Campaign Materials.</u>: 73(82%) MLAs have declared that they have spent funds on campaign materials and 16(18%) MLAs have declared that they have not spent any funds on campaign materials.
- 11. Expense on Campaign Vehicles.: 87(98%) MLAs have declared that they have spent funds on campaign vehicles and 2(2%) MLAs have declared that

they have not spent any funds on campaign vehicles.








Figure 2: Break Down of Elections Expenses Incurred by MLAs




Figure 3: Party-wise Average Expenses on Public Meetings, Processions etc. with Star Campaigners (Rs. in lakhs)




Figure 4: Party-wise Average Election Expenses on Public Meetings, Processions etc. without Star Campaigners (Rs.in lakhs)




Figure 5: Party-wise Average Election Expenses on Campaign Materials (Rs.in lakhs)




Figure 6: Party-wise Average Election Expenses on Campaign Electronic Media (Rs. in lakhs)




Figure 7: Party-wise Average Election Expenses on Campaign Vehicles (Rs. in lakhs)




Figure 8: Party-wise Average Election Expenses on Campaign Workers (Rs. in lakhs)

Summary and Highlights of Funds Raised by MLAs in the Haryana Assembly 2019 Elections




Figure 9: Percentage Break-down of Funds Raised by MLAs

- Percentage break-down of funds received by MLAs: Out of the total funds received by MLAs, 12% funds were raised from political parties, 5% were raised by MLAs themselves and 83% funds were raised from other sources.
- 2. <u>MLAs Who Raised Funds from Political Parties</u>: Out of the 89 MLAs analyzed, **35 (39%) MLAs** have declared that **they have received funds** from political parties and **54 (61%) MLAs** have declared that **they have not received any funds from** political parties.
- 3. <u>MLAs Who Raised Funds through any person/ company/ firm/ associations/ body of persons etc as loan, gift or donation etc:</u> Out of the 89 MLAs analyzed, **88(99%) MLAs** have declared that **they have received funds from** *any person/ company/ firm/ associations/ body of persons etc as loan, gift or donation etc.* and **1 MLA** has declared that **he has not received any funds from** *any person/ company/ firm/ associations/ body of persons etc as loan, gift or donation etc.*





- 4. <u>Self-funds used for election campaign</u>: Out of the 89 MLAs analyzed, 40(45%) MLAs have declared that they have used their own funds for their election campaign and 49(55%) MLAs have declared that they have not used any of their own funds for their election campaign
- 5. <u>Average funds raised from Political Parties (Party-wise)</u>: On an average a MLA from BJP raised 85.45% and on an average a MLA from INC raised only 46.55% of his/her election expense funds from the political party.
- 6. <u>Average funds raised through any person/company/firm/associations/body of persons etc as loan, gift or donation etc (Party-wise)</u>: On an average a MLA from BJP raised 2.93% of his/her election expense funds from any person/company/firm/associations/body of persons etc. as loan, gift or donation. Similarly, a MLA from INC raised 12.46%, a MLA from Jannayak Janta Party raised 38.21% and a MLA from Independent raised 40.15% of his/her election expense funds from any person/ company/ firm/ associations/ body of persons etc. as loan, gift or donation.


