




Figure: Number of adjournments of Sittings of House

❖ There were total 44 Bills tabled in the 6<sup>th</sup> Delhi Assembly and all of them were passed.




Figure: Time taken to Pass a Bill in 6th Delhi Assembly




Figure: Number of Bills Passed in 6th Delhi Assembly
