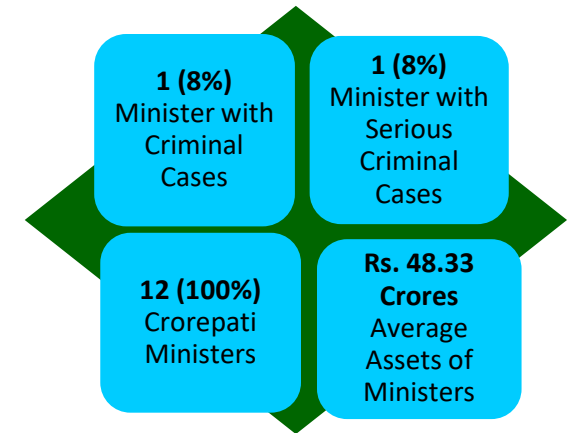

Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and Arunachal Pradesh Election Watch have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of all **12 Ministers** including Chief Minister from **Arunachal Pradesh State Assembly Elections 2024**.

The information is based on the affidavits submitted by the ministers prior to 2024 Arunachal Pradesh Assembly Elections.

Criminal Background

- **Ministers with Criminal Cases:** Out of the **12** ministers analysed, **1 (8%)** minister has declared criminal cases against himself.

Criteria for serious criminal cases

1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
2. If an offence is non-bailable
3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
8. Crimes against women.

Financial Background

- **Crorepoti Ministers:** Out of the **12** ministers analysed, all **12 (100%)** are crorepatis.
- **Average Assets:** The average assets of **12** ministers analysed is **Rs 48.33 crores**.
- **Minister with Highest Assets:** The minister with the highest declared total assets is **Pema Khandu** from **Mukto (ST)** constituency with assets worth **Rs. 332.56 crores**.
- **Minister with Lowest Assets:** The minister with the lowest declared total assets is **Gabriel Denwang Wangsu** from **Kanubari (ST)** constituency with assets worth **Rs. 1.65 crore**.
- **Liabilities:** **5** ministers have declared liabilities out of which the minister with the highest liabilities is **Pema Khandu** of **Mukto (ST)** constituency with **Rs. 180.27 crores** of liabilities.

Other Background details (Education, Gender, Age)

- **Ministers' Education:** **3 (25%)** Ministers have declared their educational qualification **10th and 12th** standard while **9 (75%)** Ministers have declared having an educational qualification of **graduate and above**.
- **Ministers' Age:** **4 (33%)** ministers have declared their age to be between **41 and 50 years** while **8 (67%)** ministers have declared their age to be between **51 and 80 years**.
- **Women Ministers:** Out of **12** ministers, **1** is a woman.
