

Analysis of the MLAs from Arunachal Pradesh

The following report consists of the financial and criminal details of the Members of legislative Assemblies (MLAs) from Arunachal Pradesh and an overall comparative analysis. As mentioned before, the state has 60 seats of Legislative Assembly and it is represented by 2 seats in Lok Sabha and 1 in Rajya Sabha. The following table gives a summary of the details of all the MLAs:

Crorepati MLAs


The highest declared assets are those of Gegong Apang from Indian National Congress (INC) with both movable and immovable assets standing at Rs.9, 36, 50,000. The first 6 MLAs with assets running into crores are from INC followed by 3 from BJP and 1 from NCP. Nikh Kamin from NCP, with assets worth over 2 crores also has 2 serious criminal charges pending against him. None of the MLAs with declared assets more than a crore has given their PAN number.



ANALYSIS OF THE MLAs of ARUNACHAL PRADESH (based on 2004 assembly elections)




