Summary and Highlights

Maharashtra Election Watch and Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analysed the self- sworn affidavits of **16 candidates** who are contesting for the **8** seats in the **Maharashtra Legislative Council Biennial Elections of 2015**, from Local Authorities Constituencies.

Criminal Background

- <u>Candidates with Criminal Cases</u>: Out of the **16** candidates analysed, **12 (75%)** candidates have declared criminal cases against them.
- <u>Candidates with Serious Criminal Cases</u>: Out of the 16 candidates, 2 (13%) candidates have declared serious criminal cases.
- Party wise Candidates with Criminal Cases:

3 (100%) out of **3** candidates analysed from INC, **3 (100%)** out of **3** candidates analysed from NCP, **2 (100%)** out of **2** candidates analysed from BJP and **2 (67%)** out of **3** candidates analysed from **Shiv Sena** have declared **criminal cases** against themselves in their affidavits.

Criteria for serious criminal cases

- 1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
- 2. If an offence is non-bailable
- 3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
- 4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
- 5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
- 6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
- 7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
- 8. Crimes against women.
- <u>Party wise Candidates with Serious Criminal Cases:</u> 1 (33%) out of 3 candidates analysed from INC and 1 (33%) out of 3 candidates analysed from NCP have declared serious criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.

It is also interesting that all 5 (100%) out of 5 Indpendents are also crorepatis.

- <u>Party-wise Average Assets</u>: Among major parties, the average assets per candidate for **3** analysed **INC** candidates is **Rs 65.64 crores**, **3** analysed **NCP** candidates have average assets of **Rs.41.05 crores**, **3** analysed **Shiv Sena** candidates have average assets of **Rs. 8.60 crores** and **2** analysed **BJP** candidates have average assets of **Rs. 1.91 crores**.


