The Commission has directed that all political parties, whether recognised as National parties or State parties or registered-unrecognised political parties, should submit to the Commission, for its scrutiny, the details of the expenditure incurred or authorised by them in connection with the election of their respective sandidates at the current general elections to the House of the People and State Legislative Assemblies and the

The above details of expenditure should be submitted by all political parties as soon as may be after the current elections are over and in, any case, not later than 5.00 p.m. on 31st July, 1996. These details should cover all expenditure incurred or authorised by the parties from 19th March, 1996, i.e., the date on which the Commission announced the programme for the current elections, and till the completion of slections in all the constituencies in which they have the tup their candidates.

The expenditure should be classified under two main heads, namely, (1) expenditure incurred or authorized on general party propaganda, and (2) rependiture incurred or authorised in connection with the election of individual candidates. The expenditure main the head (2) should give break-up of such
