



Financial Details of Political Parties

Executive Summary

• **Donations to Parties**

- INC, in its IT Returns, has declared a total income of Rs 2,008.71 lakhs with income from donations being Rs 27,250.48 lakhs followed by BJP, with total income of Rs 99,476.67 lakhs and donations of Rs 82,000.50 lakhs
- o Party which showed the least income between FY 2004-05 and 2010-11 is CPI (Rs 843.6 lakhs) with donations amounting to Rs 458.96 lakhs
- Of the Regional Parties, maximum total income was shown by SP (Rs 27,855.65 lakhs) with donations amounting to Rs 21,266.84 lakhs followed by AIADMK (Rs 5997.33 lakhs) with donations of Rs 2,946.49 lakhs and TDP (Rs 5390.62 lakhs) with donations amounting to Rs 3,235.14 lakhs

Share of donations from total income

- BJP showed the maximum share of income from donations with 82.43% of total income coming from contribution to the party while INC has only 13.57% of its total income coming from donations
- Party with the least share of donations from total income is NCP with only 8.10% of donations contributing to it total income of Rs 16,082.35 lakhs
- Of the Regional Parties, 97.48% of the total income of JD(U) came from donations while 95.94% share of income of TRS came from donations
- o Total donations of Rs 21,266.84 lakhs to SP forms 76.35% of its total income

Contribution above Rs 20,000

- Party with maximum amount received as contribution in sums greater than Rs 20,000 is INC (Rs 17,796.60 lakhs) followed by BJP (Rs 15,364.11 lakhs)
- BSP has stated that the party has never received any contribution above Rs 20,000 from a single donor between FY 2004-05 and 2010-11 while its total income is Rs 48,428.51 lakhs
- For INC, only 8.86% of the total income of the party is derived from donations above Rs 20,000 while
 15.44% of the total income of BJP is derived from donations above Rs 20,000

• Sources of Income

- Voluntary contribution/ donation is one of the top three sources of income of all the National and the Regional parties
- 77.35% of total income of INC and 88.33% of total income of NCP come from sale of coupons while membership fee and levy form the main sources of income of CPM and CPI
- Interest from banks and deposits is also one of the top three sources of income of National and Regional Parties

• <u>Items of Expenditure</u>

- The maximum expenditure for INC has been towards Election expenses (Rs 92,506.40 lakhs) followed by expenses towards Aid to Other Expenses (Rs 17,116.47 lakhs) and travelling (Rs 10,749.25 lakhs)
- The maximum expenditure of BJP has been towards Advertising & publicity (Rs 35,720.64 lakhs) followed by travelling (Rs 18,889.46 lakhs) and meeting (Rs 10,456.60 lakhs)
- The maximum expenditure for SP has been towards Travelling & conveyance (Rs 6,030.35 lakhs)
 followed by expenses towards Aid to Advertisement (Rs 3,361.93 lakhs) and Election (Rs 868.06 lakhs)
- It is seen from the percentage shares that INC has spent 55.74% on election expenses while BJP has spent 44.09% on advertising and publicity, BSP 32.69% on Publicity Expenses, CPM 21.91% on Salaries, SP 49.16% on Travelling & Conveyance, JDU 30.42% on Contribution to candidates/ Donation.
