Haryana Election Watch and Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of all **90** newly elected MLAs in the Haryana 2019 Assembly Elections.




Figure: Final Party Position

CRIMINAL BACKGROUND

- MLAs with criminal cases:** Out of the 90 MLAs analysed, 12(13%) MLAs have declared criminal cases against themselves. Out of 90 MLAs analysed during Haryana Assembly elections in 2014, 9 (10%) MLAs had declared criminal cases against themselves.
- MLAs with serious criminal cases:** 7(8%) MLAs have declared serious criminal cases their affidavits. Out of 90 MLAs analysed during Haryana Assembly elections in 2014, 5 (6%) MLAs had declared serious criminal cases against themselves.





Figure: Comparison of MLAs with declared criminal cases in 2014 vs 2019



Criteria for serious criminal cases

1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
2. If an offence is non-bailable
3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
8. Crimes against women.

- **Party wise MLAs with criminal cases:** 4(13%) out of 31 MLAs from INC, 2 (5%) out of 40 MLAs from BJP, 1 (10%) out of 10 MLAs from Jannayak Janta Party, 1 (100%) out of 1 MLA from INLD, 1 (100%) out of 1 MLA from Haryana Lokhit Party and 3 (43%) out of 7 Independent MLAs have declared criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.
- **Party wise MLAs with serious criminal cases:** 4(13%) out of 31 MLAs from INC, 1 (100%) out of 1 MLA from Haryana Lokhit Party and 2 (29%) out of 7 Independent MLAs have declared serious criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.




Figure: Party wise Comparison of MLAs with declared criminal cases in 2014 and 2019

FINANCIAL BACKGROUND

- **Crorepatis MLAs**: Out of the **90** newly elected MLAs, **84 (93%)** are crorepatis. Out of **90** MLAs analysed during **Haryana 2014 assembly elections**, **75 (83%)** MLAs were crorepatis.




Figure: Comparision of crorepati MLAs: 2014 vs 2019

- **Partywise crorepati MLAs**: **37 (93%)**out of 40 MLAs from **BJP**, **29 (94%)**out of 31 MLAs from **INC**, **10 (100%)**out of 10 MLAs from **Jannayak Janta Party**, **6 (86%)** out of 7 Independent MLAs and **1(100%)** each MLAs from **INLD** and **Haryana Lokhit Party** have declared assets valued more than **Rs 1 crore**.




Figure: Party wise Comparison of Crorepati MLAs in 2014 vs 2019




Figure: Share of Wealth among MLAs




Figure: Comparision of Average Assets (Rs. in Crores): 2014 vs 2019

OTHER BACKGROUND DETAILS

- **Education Details of MLAs:** 27 (30%) MLAs have declared their educational qualification to be between 5th pass and 12th pass while 62 (69%) MLAs have declared having an educational qualification of graduate or above.
- **Age details of MLAs:** 10 (11%) MLAs have declared their age to be between 31 and 40 years while 17 (19%) MLAs have declared their age to be between 41 and 50 years. There are 57(63%) MLAs who have declared their age to be between 51 and 70 years while 6(7%) MLAs have declared their age to be between 71 and 80 years.
- **Gender details of MLAs:** Out of 90 MLAs, 9 (10%) MLAs are women. In 2014, out of 90 MLAs, 13 (14%) MLAs were women.

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF ASSETS OF RE-ELECTED MLAS

- **Number of re-elected MLAs:** Number of re-elected MLAs analysed in the Haryana assembly elections of **2019** is **29**.
- **Average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2014:** The average assets of re-elected MLAs in **2014** was **Rs 13.73 crores**
- **Average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2019:** The average assets of re-elected MLAs in **2019** is **Rs 16.98 crores**.
- **Average growth in assets of re-elected MLAs from 2014 to 2019:** The growth in average assets of re-elected MLAs is **Rs 3.25 crores i.e. by 24%**.




Figure: Analysis of MLAs on the basis of education




Figure: Analysis of MLAs on the basis of age groups


