Himachal Pradesh Election Watch* Lok Sabha elections 2009

Lok Sabha 2009 elections for four constituencies in Himachal Pradesh were held on 13 May 2009. This chapter includes the analysis of voting trend, criminalization, money power, gender etc in these elections. Information provided by ECI and details from the affidavits filed by contesting candidates have been used for above analysis.

Growth of political parties

In Lok Sabha 2004, 5 parties contested elections which rose to 9 in Lok Sabha elections 2009. This reflects a rise of 80% in the number of parties from 2004 Lok Sabha elections to 2009 Lok Sabha elections.

Growth in number of candidates

A total of 31 candidates contested Lok Sabha 2009 elections from Himachal Pradesh as compared to 23 candidates in Lok Sabha 2004. This shows a growth of 35% in number of candidates contesting in 2009.

Executive summary for candidates and MPs

Summary for candidates

- Affidavits of 30 out of 31 candidates who contested elections were analyzed by Himachal Pradesh election Watch (HPEW) for Lok Sabha 2009 elections.
- Out of these 30 candidates, 1 candidate or 3.33% declared pending criminal cases against him. The candidate contested election for CPM from Mandi constituency and had 1 pending criminal case against him.
- A total of 9 out of 30 candidates' i.e. 30% were crorepatis.
- Among major parties, average assets for candidates of BJP and INC were approximately about Rs.1.65 crores and Rs.6.50 crores respectively.
- A total of 10 candidates i.e. 33.33% had not furnished PAN card details.
- Number of women candidates was only 1 (3%) as compared to 30 male candidates (97%).
- About 57% candidates (17 out of 30) were graduates & above.
- Total voting in the state was 58%. BJP managed to get approx 50% of the votes polled and 29 % of the registered voters. INC managed to get 46 % votes and 27% registered voters.

Summary for MPs

- The number of Crorepati MPs has increased from 1 in Lok Sabha 2004 to 3 in Lok Sabha 2009. (Increase by 200%).
- All 4 winning candidates were either from BJP or INC. 3 candidates of BJP and 1 of INC won the elections.
- The assets for MPs of BJP were Rs. 2.41 crores, Rs. 1.10 crores and Rs. 34 lacs. MP from INC had assets worth Rs. 22.5 crores
- Average asset for a MP from HP is Rs. 6.59 crores.
- Himachal Pradesh does not have any women MP.

Voting and winning trend

Voting analysis


Total voting in the state was only 58%. BJP managed approx 50% of the votes cast and 29 % of the registered voters. INC managed to get 46 % votes cast and 27% registered voters. About 95% of the votes cast went in favor of either BJP or INC. Other political parties and independent candidates did not receive a sizable amount of votes cast. The total electorate in HP was 46, 06,674 and the total votes cast were 26, 90,290.

Analysis based on pending criminal cases

Pending criminal cases- analysis for candidates and MPs

A total of 30 affidavits were analyzed by Himachal Pradesh Election Watch for Lok Sabha 2009 elections. Out of these 30 candidates, 1 candidate or 3.33% declared pending criminal cases against him. This CPM candidate contested election from Mandi constituency and lost. Currently there are no pending criminal cases against any MP from Himachal Pradesh.






Analysis based on assets- for MPs

Out of the 4 MPs in Lok Sabha 2009, 3 are crorepatis as compared to 1 crorepati MP from Lok Sabha 2004, i.e. an increase of 200%. The average asset of a MP in Lok Sabha 2004 was Rs 6.3 crores which rose to Rs 6.6 crores in Lok Sabha 2009. Between Lok Sabha 2004 & Lok Sabha 2009 there has been an average asset increase of 5 % for MPs.

Chances of winning based on assets

The table below reflects that 3 winning candidates (75 % of total MPs) have been those having total assets worth 50 lakhs or more. This clearly shows that chances of winning and total assets of a candidate are directly proportional to each other.




<u>Asset position</u> in constituency among candidates and <u>chances of winning</u>

The following table gives an analysis of asset position in constituency among candidates (highest asset to lowest asset) and their chances of winning. From all the 4 constituencies, candidates holding top 3 positions with highest declared assets according to their own self sworn affidavits emerged as MPs. This reflects that money power influences the chances of winning to a great extent.
