Jharkhand Election Watch* Lok Sabha elections 2009

Lok Sabha 2009 elections were held in two phases in Jharkhand on April 16, 2009 and April 23, 2009. This chapter includes the analysis of voting trend, criminalization, money power, gender etc in these elections. Information provided by ECI and details from the affidavits filed by contesting candidates have been used for above analysis.

Growth of political parties

In Lok Sabha 2004, 26 parties contested from Jharkhand which rose to 43 parties in Lok Sabha 2009 elections. This reflects a rise of 65% in the number of parties from Lok Sabha 2004 elections to Lok Sabha 2009 elections.

Growth in number of candidates

In Jharkhand a total of 249 candidates contested Lok Sabha 2009 elections as compared to 182 candidates in Lok Sabha 2004 elections. This shows a growth of 37% in the number of candidates contesting in 2009.

Executive summary for <u>candidates</u> and <u>MPs</u>

Summary for candidates

- Affidavits of 172 candidates out of 249 candidates in Lok Sabha 2009 elections from Jharkhand were analyzed by Jharkhand Election Watch (JEW).
- Out of these 172 candidates, 54 candidates or 31% declared pending criminal cases against them. JMM had 7 out of 8 (87.5%) candidates with pending criminal cases, INC had 5 out of 9 (56%) candidates with pending criminal cases, BJP had 6 out of 12 (50%) candidates with pending criminal cases and JVM had 7 out of 14 (50%) candidates with pending criminal cases.
- Out of these 54 candidates with pending criminal cases, 23 had pending serious criminal cases like murder, attempt to murder, kidnapping, robbery, extortion etc. JMM had 3 candidates; JVM & INC had 2 candidates each with pending serious criminal cases.
- Candidates of major parties in Jharkhand- JMM, INC and BJP were analyzed for Lok Sabha 2004 elections. Out
 of the 26 candidates of these three major political parties, 13 (50%) had pending criminal cases against them.
 Comparing this to Lok Sabha 2009 elections, there were 29 candidates of these three main parties JMM, INC &
 BJP and out of these 29 candidates 18 (62%) had pending criminal cases against them.
- There were 121 IPC charges of heinous nature on the candidates which included murder, attempt to murder, kidnapping, extortion, etc.

- There were total 12 red alert constituencies where 3 or more contesting candidates had pending criminal cases. Godda & Dhanbad each had 7 candidates with pending criminal cases.
- Out of 172 candidates, 20 candidates i.e. 12% were crorepatis.
- A total of 22 candidates declared liabilities of 5 lakhs and above.
- Among major parties, the average asset per candidate for BJP was Rs. 1.87 crores, JMM was Rs 61 Lakhs, INC was Rs.2.35 crores, and JVM Rs.2.17 crores.
- Out of 172 candidates, 91 i.e.53% of candidates had not furnished PAN card details.
- Number of women candidates was just 14 (6%) as compared to 235 of men (94%).
- 45% candidates (77 of 172) were graduates & above.
- None of the parties managed to get votes anywhere near to 50%. The highest votes polled were approx 28% for BJP and it was about 14% of the total registered voters. INC managed 15% of the votes and JMM managed 12%.

Summary for MPs

- Out of 14 MPs, 8 (57%) have pending criminal cases against them. Comparing this to Lok Sabha 2004, 7 MPs out of 14 (50%) had pending criminal cases against them.
- Out of these 8 MPs with pending criminal cases, there are pending serious criminal cases against 2 (14%) MPs. Contrasting this with Lok Sabha 2004, 3 out of 7 (21.43%) MPs had serious pending criminal cases against them.
- As the number of MPs with pending criminal cases has increased from 7 in Lok Sabha 2004 to 8 in Lok Sabha 2009, so is the number of total criminal cases against MPs. It has increased from 14 in Lok Sabha 2004 to 48 in Lok Sabha 2009. Similarly the number of total serious IPC sections against MPs has also increased from 6 in 2004 to 54 in 2009.
- The number of crorepati MPs has increased from 3 in Lok Sabha 2004 to 6 in current Lok Sabha.
- Among major parties, the average asset per MP for INC is Rs.2.78 crores, BJP Rs 2.69 crores, JMM approx Rs. 44 Lakhs
 & JVM approx Rs 21 lakhs.
- Average asset of a MP from Jharkhand is approx Rs 2crores.
- None of the women candidates managed to win in elections.


Voting analysis

The % of votes cast for major parties in Jharkhand clearly shows that none of the parties got anywhere close to the 50% mark. Total voting in Jharkhand was 52%. BJP which emerged as a largest party in Jharkhand in 2009 elections after winning 8 out of 14 Lok Sabha seats managed to get only 28% of the votes cast and it is only 14% of the registered voters. The total electorates in Jharkhand were 1,77,13,174 and the total votes cast were 91,35,818.



Analysis based on pending criminal cases

Pending criminal cases- analysis for candidates

A total of 172 affidavits out of 249 were analysed by Jharkhand Election Watch (JEW) for Lok Sabha 2009 elections. Out of these 172 candidates, 54 (31%) candidates declared pending criminal cases against them. Out of these 54 candidates with pending criminal cases, 23 had pending serious criminal cases like murder, attempt to murder, kidnapping, robbery, extortion etc.


Party wise break up for candidates with pending criminal cases

In Jharkhand, 54 candidates out of 172 contested in Lok Sabha 2009 elections had pending criminal cases against them. 23 out of 54 had serious criminal cases pending against them. 88% candidates of JMM had pending criminal cases against them whereas 50% of candidates from both JVM & BJP in Jharkhand had pending criminal cases. Party wise details are given below.

Figure: Serious IPC section break up for candidates of major parties





Figure: Comparison total serious crimes vs. total violent crimes (murder, kidnapping etc) - Party wise





<u>Party wise</u> comparison of pending criminal cases on <u>candidates</u> in Lok Sabha 2004 & Lok Sabha 2009

A comparison between Lok Sabha 2009 & Lok Sabha 2004 elections of candidates from three major parties and with pending criminal cases is give in the following table. For INC & JMM the number of candidates with pending criminal cases has increased in 2009 elections as compared to 2004 elections, whereas for BJP the percentage remains the same. This can be seen from table below.

Details of <u>candidates</u> based on pending criminal cases

The table below lists top 20 candidates with serious pending criminal cases. Most of them have been charged multiple times with murder, attempt to murder, kidnapping, dacoity etc. Kameshwar Baitha from Palamau had 51 counts of serious IPCs pending against him. Samaresh Singh of Dhanbad had 14 charges of murder, attempt to murder & kidnapping etc pending against him. Out of these 20 candidates with most serious pending criminal cases, only 2candidates won and rest 18 were rejected by the voters. The detailed list is given below.

Pending criminal cases- analysis for MPs


Out of 14 MPs from Jharkhand in Lok Sabha 2009, 8 MPs have pending criminal cases against them. Out of these 8 MPs there are pending serious criminal cases against 2 MPs (14%). In Lok Sabha 2004, 3 or 21 % MPs had serious pending criminal cases.

Given below is a comparative analysis for MPs with pending criminal cases elected from Jharkhand. The presence of MPs with pending criminal cases from Jharkhand in Lok Sabha 2009 has increased by 14%. The number of total pending criminal cases has also increased by almost 243%. This means that there were an average of 2 cases per tainted MP in Lok Sabha 2009.

Serious crimes distribution – for <u>candidates</u> of major parties

There are several cases of violent crimes like murder, attempt to murder, theft, extortion, robbery etc pending against MPs from Jharkhand. 

Figure: Crorepati candidates from major parties






Analysis based on assets- for MPs

Out of 14 MPs in Lok Sabha 2009 from Jharkhand 6 are crorepatis. In 2004 there were 3 crorepati MPs from Jharkhand. This shows an increase of 100% in the number of crorepati MPs in Lok Sabha 2009 from Lok Sabha 2004. The average asset of a MP in Lok Sabha 2004 was Rs 58 Lac (Approx) which rose to Rs 2 cr in Lok Sabha 2009. Between 2004 & 2009 there has been an average asset increase of 252% for MPs.

Chances of winning based on assets

As can be seen from the table, the higher the assets the more are the chances of winning of a candidate. In the Lok Sabha 2009 elections, 25% of the candidates who declared assets more than Rs 5 crore and above won. On the other hand only 1% of candidates with assets less than Rs 10 lakh won. The election results seemed to be highly influenced by the money power of the candidates.



Figure: Comparison average assets for candidates & MPs in Lok Sabha 2009




