



Analysis of Cabinet Ministers of Karnataka (2013)

Executive Summary

- National Election Watch (NEW) has analyzed the affidavits of all the 29 cabinet ministers including the Chief Minister, submitted to the Election Commission of India from the state of Karnataka.
- Given below is the Comparison of Cabinet Ministers between the Karnataka 2008 and the Karnataka 2013 Assembly Elections:

 28% ministers i.e. (8 out of 29 analyzed) have self declared criminal cases as per their affidavits filed during the Assembly Elections in 2013. 3 ministers out of these 29 analyzed or 10% have declared serious IPC charges like criminal intimidation, injuring or defiling place of worship, forgery, undue influence or personation at an election etc. against them.

(Note:-The parameters for classifying an IPC as serious are as follows: If offence has a punishment of more than five years; if offence is non bailable; if offence is serious from view point of elections; if offence entails loss to exchequer and if it is mentioned in the Representation of the People's Act. For an IPC to be considered serious it must fit into atleast one of the above parameters)

- Among these 8 Ministers who have declared criminal cases against themselves, the following Ministers have declared serious criminal charges against them: 1) Qamarul Islam (of INC from Gulbarga Uttar) has declared 1 case against himself including charges related to criminal intimidation, causing disappearance of information and injuring or defiling place of worship 2) Umashree (of INC from Terdal) has declared 2 criminal cases including charges related to undue influence and personation at an election and making illegal payments in connection with an election 3)Dr. Sharan Prakash Rudrappa Patil (of INC from Sedam) has declared 1 criminal case including charges related to forgery.

Assets of Satish Laxmanarao Jarakiholi (of INC from YEMKANAMARDI constituency) have increased by Rs 47.66 crores, from Rs 15.39 crores in 2008 to Rs 63.05 crores in 2013. Assets of Ramalinga Reddy (of INC from B.T.M LAYOUT) have risen by Rs 27.28 crores, from Rs 8.65 crore in 2008 to Rs 35.93 crores in 2013.
- Asset decrease in 5 years (2008-2013): 2 Ministers have reported decrease in assets in 2013 as compared to the value of their assets in 2008. Among them the highest decrease has been shown by Deshpande Raghunath (22% decline in assets, Rs 145.57 crores in 2008 to Rs 113.93 Crores in 2013) from HALIYAL constituency, P.T .Parameshwaranaik (9% reduction in assets, from Rs 1.62 crores in 2008 election to Rs 1.48 crores in 2013
- 100% or all of the 29 Cabinet Ministers including the Chief Minister are crorepatis. In 2008,
 75% Cabinet ministers were crorepatis.
- Overall, 93% or 203 out of the 218 analyzed MLAs are crorepatis in Karnataka assembly 2013.
- SANTHOSH LAD of INC from Kalaghatgi constituency has the highest assets (Rs. 186.40 Crores) among the Karnataka cabinet ministers followed by RAGHUNATH DESHPANDE of INC from Haliyal with assets worth Rs.113.93 Crores followed by SHAMANUR SHIVASHANKARAPPA of INC from Davanagare South Constituency with assets worth Rs. 67.89 Crores among the Karnataka cabinet ministers.
- The average asset of a minister in Karnataka assembly 2013 is 22.77 crores. The average asset of a minister in 2008 assembly was Rs. 6.96 crores
- The growth in average asset per minister is 227% from 2008 to 2013.

- The average asset per MLA in Karnataka assembly 2013 is 23.54 crores for 218 out of 224 MLAs analysed. In 2008 Karnataka assembly the average asset of 214 MLAs analysed was 5.98 crores.
- There was a growth of 294% increase in average asset of MLAs from 2008 to 2013 assembly elections.
- Party-wise average assets in 2013 Karnataka assembly is 31.39 crores for INC (118 MLAs analysed), 13.06 crores for BJP (40 MLAs analysed), 12.13 crores for JD(S) (38 MLAs analysed), 22.96 Crore for Independent MLAs (9 MLAs analysed) and 5.51 crore for KJP MLAs (6 MLAs analyzed).
- Party-wise average assets in 2008 Karnataka assembly is 9.55 crores for INC (70 MLAs analysed), 4.43 crores JD (S) (26 MLAs analysed), 4.35 crores BJP (112 MLAs analysed) and 1.48 crores for Independent MLAs (6 MLAs analysed).
- **U.T.Khadar** with assets worth Rs 1.11 Crores has the lowest assets among all the ministers analysed in Karnataka.
- Among all the 29 ministers analysed, only 1 is a woman.





Background

Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and National Election Watch (NEW), a nationwide campaign comprising of more than 1200 NGOs and other citizen led organizations, has been working on electoral reforms, improving democracy and governance in India. National Election Watch (NEW) has analysed the affidavits of all the 29 cabinet ministers including the Chief Minister in Karnataka.

This report is based on the analysis of these affidavits. The following pages give analysis of criminal, financial and other background information of the Ministers.
