

Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and Madhya Pradesh Election Watch (MPEW) had filed RTI applications to the Madhya Pradesh Assembly Secretariat asking for the information pertaining to the performance of the MLAs and the Legislative Assembly. This report is based on information available on the website of Madhya Pradesh Legislative Assembly and from the RTI responses received from Madhya Pradesh Assembly Secretariat. There are 230 seats in Madhya Pradesh Assembly, however this report also includes the analysis for the MLAs who have resigned or got elected through

bye-elections.







#### Analysis of Number of Sittings in Each Session of Madhya Pradesh Legislative Assembly

- On an average, Madhya Pradesh State Assembly sat for 16 days per year.
- The longest sessions were the 3rd session (8th July to 26th July 2019) and 8th session (22nd February to 26th March 2021). Both had 13 sittings.




Figure: No. of sittings held in Madhya Pradesh Assembly during the period 2018-2023





- The highest number of hours contributed for assembly sittings were **116.83** hours in **2019** where assembly had **26** sittings.
- The lowest number of hours contributed for assembly sittings were **1.53** hours in **2020** where assembly had **4** sittings.




Figure: Year Wise Total Time Contributed for Assembly Sessions (in Hours)




Figure: Party Wise Average Attendance




Figure: Party Wise Average Number of Questions Asked

 Highest number of Questions were related to Urban Development And Housing, Panchayat And Rural Development, Revenue, School Education and Public Works.




Figure: Top 15 - Category Wise Questions Asked

- Out of these 140 Bills, 127(91%) Bills were passed.




Figure: Percentage of Bills Passed in 15th Madhya Pradesh Assembly




