




# **Summary and Highlights**

Meghalaya Election Watch and Association for Democratic Reforms have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of all **12 Ministers** including Chief Minister from Meghalaya State Assembly 2023.

The information is based on the affidavits submitted by the candidates prior to 2023 Meghalaya Assembly Elections.

- Ministers with Criminal Cases: 1(8%) minister has declared criminal case against himself.
- Ministers with Serious Criminal Cases: 1(8%) minister has declared serious criminal case against himself.

#### Criteria for serious criminal cases

- 1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
- 2. If an offence is non-bailable
- 3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
- 4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
- Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
- 6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
- 7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
- 8. Crimes against women.





## **Financial Background**

- Crorepati Ministers: Out of the 12 ministers analysed, all 12 (100%) are crorepatis.
- Average Assets: The average assets of 12 ministers analysed is Rs 11.45 crores.
- Minister with Highest Assets: The minister with the highest declared total assets is Sniawbhalang Dhar from Nartiang (ST) constituency with assets worth Rs. 45.35 crores.
- Minister with Lowest Assets: The minister with the lowest declared total assets is Rakkam A. Sangma from Rongara Siju (ST) constituency with assets worth Rs. 1.71 crores.
- <u>Liabilities:</u> 7 ministers have declared liabilities out of which the minister with the highest liabilities is **Sniawbhalang Dhar** of **Nartiang (ST)** constituency with **Rs. 3.42** crores of liabilities.

### Other Background details (Education, Gender, Age)

- Ministers' Education: 5 (42%) ministers have declared their educational qualification to be between 10<sup>th</sup> pass and 12<sup>th</sup> pass, while 6 (50%) ministers have declared having an educational qualification of graduate and above. One minister is a Diploma holder.
- Ministers' Age: 6 (50%) ministers have declared their age to be between 25 and 50 years while 6 (50%) ministers have declared their age to be between 51 and 60 years.
- Women Ministers: Out of 12 ministers, 1 is a woman.
