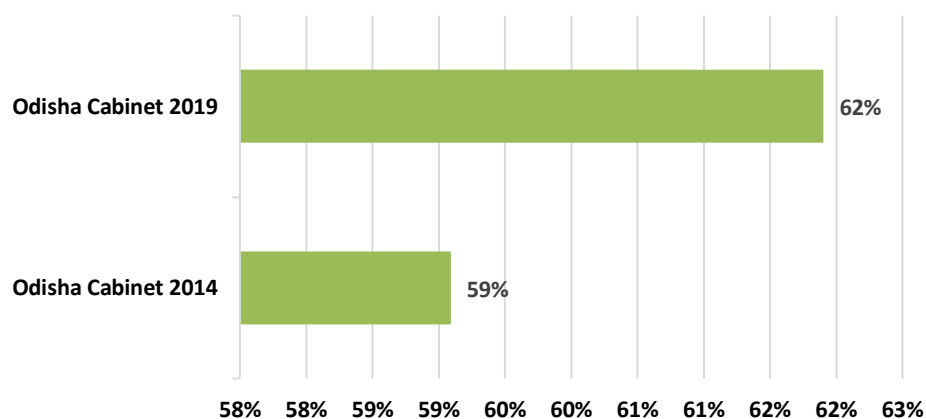

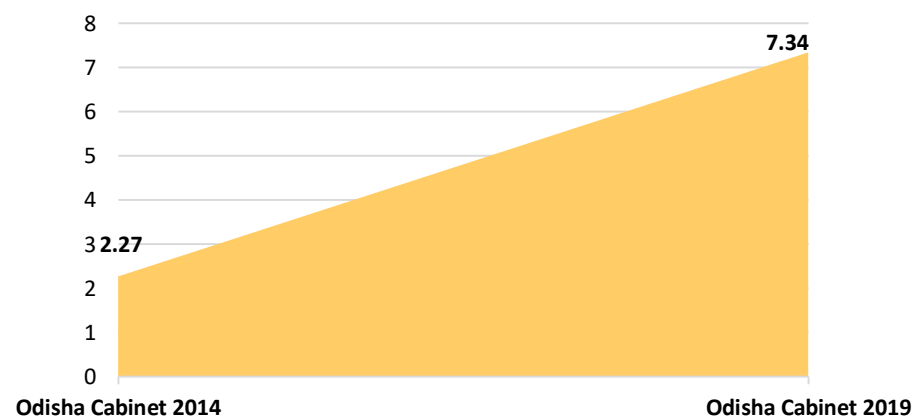

Odisha Cabinets 2014 vs. 2019

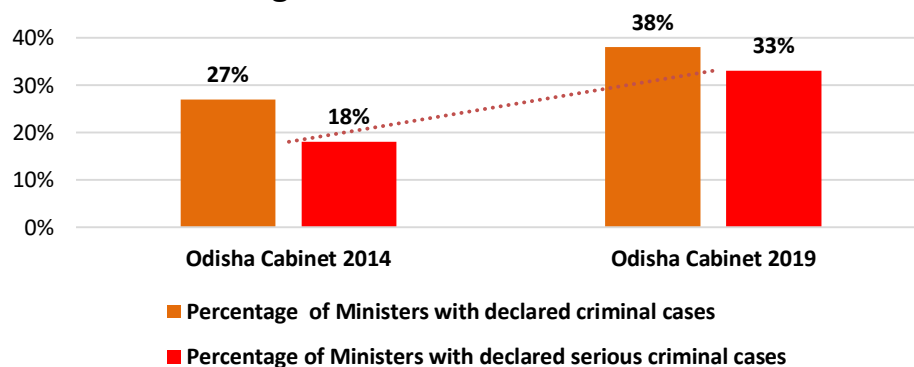
Percentage of Crorepati Ministers



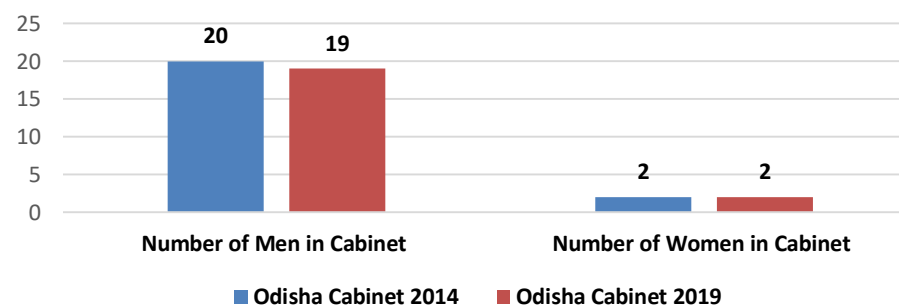
Average Assets of Ministers (Rs.in Crores)
