• Ministers with Criminal Cases: 3(50%) ministers have declared criminal cases against themselves.



• Crorepati Ministers: Out of the 6 ministers analysed, 6 (100%) are crorepatis.

- Average Assets: The average assets of 6 ministers analysed is Rs 13.66 crores.
- <u>Minister with Highest Assets:</u> The Chief Minister with the highest declared total assets is N. Rangasamy from Thattanchavady constituency with assets worth Rs. 38.39 crores.
- <u>Minister with Lowest Assets:</u> The minister with the lowest declared total assets is K. Lakshminarayanan from Raj Bhavan constituency with assets worth Rs. 2.52 crores.
- <u>Liabilities:</u> All 6 ministers have declared liabilities out of which the minister with the highest liabilities is A. Namassivayam of Mannadipet constituency with Rs. 4.66 crores of liabilities.



### Criteria for serious criminal cases

- Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
- 2. If an offence is non-bailable
- If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
- 4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
- 5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
- 6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
- 7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
- 8. Crimes against women.





# Other Background details (Education, Gender, Age)

- Ministers' Education: 2 (33%) ministers have declared their educational qualification to be 10<sup>th</sup> standard while 3 (50%) ministers have declared having an educational qualification of graduate or above. 1 minister is Diploma holder.
- Ministers' Age: A total of 2(33%) ministers have declared their age to be between 31-50 years while 4(67%) ministers have declared their age to be between 51-70 years.
- Women Ministers: Out of 6 ministers, 1 is a woman.
