Summary and Highlights

Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and **Rajasthan Election Watch** have analyzed the criminal, financial and other background details of **199** out of **200** sitting MLAs. In the current assembly one seat of **Udaipur** constituency is vacant.

This analysis is based on the affidavits submitted by the candidates prior to the 2018 Assembly elections and bye elections conducted thereafter.



CRIMINAL BACKGROUND

- **MLAs with criminal cases:** Out of 199 sitting MLAs analysed, **46 (23%)** Sitting MLAs have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- **MLAs with serious criminal cases:** **28 (14%)** Sitting MLAs have declared serious criminal cases.
- **MLAs with declared cases related to murder:** **1** Sitting MLA has declared cases related to murder (IPC section 302).
- **MLAs with declared cases related to attempt to murder:** **4** Sitting MLAs have declared cases related to attempt to murder (IPC section 307).
- **Party wise sitting MLAs with criminal cases:** **27 (25%)** out of **108** MLAs from **INC**, **11 (16%)** out of **69** MLAs from **BJP**, **2 (100%)** out of **2** MLAs from **CPI(M)** and **6 (43%)** out of **14** **Independent** MLAs have declared criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.
- **Party wise sitting MLAs with serious criminal cases:** **18 (17%)** out of **108** MLAs from **INC**, **6 (9%)** out of **69** MLAs from **BJP** and **4 (29%)** out of **14** **Independent** MLAs have declared serious criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.



Party wise percentage of MLAs with declared criminal cases




Figure: Party wise percentage of MLAs with declared criminal cases

Criteria for serious criminal cases

1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
2. If an offence is non-bailable
3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
8. Crimes against women.

FINANCIAL BACKGROUND

- **Crorepatis MLAs:** Out of **199** sitting MLAs analysed , **157 (79%)** are crorepatis.
- **Party wise crorepati MLAs:** **88 (81%)** out of **108** MLAs from **INC**, **54 (78%)** out of **69** MLAs from **BJP**, **2 (67%)** out of **3** MLAs from **Rashtriya Loktantrik Party**, **1 (100%)** out of **1** MLA from **RLD** and **12 (86%)** out of **14** **Independent** MLAs have declared assets valued more than **Rs 1 crore**.




Figure: Party Wise Percentage of Crorepati MLAs

- **Average assets:** The average of assets per sitting MLA is **Rs.7.49 crore**.
- **Party wise average assets:** The average assets per MLA for **108 INC** MLAs analysed is **Rs.9.28 crores**, **69 BJP** MLAs analysed is **Rs.5.45 crores**, **1 RLD** MLA analysed is **Rs.2.55 crores**, **2 Bhartiya Tribal Party** MLAs analysed is **Rs.7.66 lakhs**, **2 CPI(M)** MLAs analysed is **Rs.24.24 lakhs**, **3 Rashtriya Loktantrik Party** MLAs analysed is **Rs.1.19 crores** and **14 Independent** MLAs have average assets of **Rs.7.54 crores**.

OTHER BACKGROUND DETAILS

- **Education Details of MLAs:** 59(30%) MLAs have declared their educational qualification to be between 5th and 12th standard while 128 (64%) MLAs have declared having an educational qualification of graduate or above. 5 MLAs are Diploma holders. 7 MLAs have declared themselves to be just literates.
- **Age details of MLAs:** 80 (40%) MLAs have declared their age to be between 25 and 50 years while 119 (60%) MLAs have declared their age to be between 51 and 85 years.
- **Gender details of MLAs:** Out of 199 MLAs analysed, 27 (14%) MLAs are women.




Figure: Analysis of MLAs on the basis of education




Figure: Analysis of MLAs on the basis of age groups


