




Summary and Highlights

Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and Sikkim Election Watch have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of all 12 Ministers including Chief Minister from Sikkim State Assembly Elections 2024.

The information is based on the affidavits submitted by the ministers prior to 2024 Sikkim Assembly Elections.

Criminal Background

• <u>Ministers with Criminal Cases</u>: Out of the **12** ministers analysed, **1 (8%) minister** has declared criminal cases against himself.

Financial Background

- **<u>Crorepati Ministers:</u>** Out of the **12** ministers analysed, all **12 (100%)** are crorepatis.
- Average Assets: The average assets of 12 ministers analysed is Rs 21.72 crores.
- Minister with Highest Assets: The minister with the highest declared total assets is Nar Bahadur Dahal from Khamdong-Singtam constituency with assets worth Rs.
 74.10 crores.
- Minister with Lowest Assets: The minister with the lowest declared total assets is Bhim Hang Limboo from Yangthang constituency with assets worth Rs. 1.58 crore.
- Liabilities: 6 ministers have declared liabilities out of which the minister with the highest liabilities is Nar Bahadur Dahal of Khamdong-Singtam constituency with Rs.
 19.01 crores of liabilities.

Other Background details (Education, Gender, Age)

- <u>Ministers' Education</u>: **5 (42%)** Ministers have declared their educational qualification **8th and 12th** standard while **7 (58%)** Ministers have declared having an educational qualification of graduate and above.
- Ministers' Age: 3 (25%) ministers have declared their age to be between 31 and 50 years while 9 (75%) ministers have declared their age to be between 51 and 70 years.
- **Women Ministers:** Among the 12 ministers analyzed, there is no woman.

Criteria for serious criminal cases

- 1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
- 2. If an offence is non-bailable
- 3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
- 4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
- 5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
- Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
- 7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
- 8. Crimes against women.
