Summary and Highlights

Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and **Sikkim Election Watch** have analyzed the criminal, financial and other background details of **31** out of **32** sitting MLAs. In the current assembly one seat of **Gnathang-Machong** constituency is vacant.

This analysis is based on the affidavits submitted by the candidates prior to the 2019 Assembly elections and bye elections conducted thereafter.

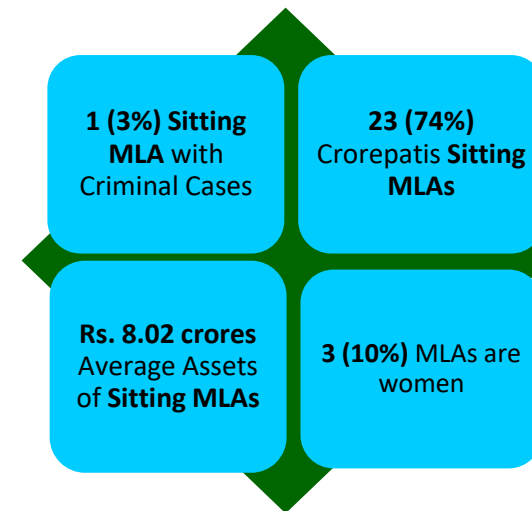

- Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
- If an offence is non-bailable
- If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
- Offence related to loss to exchequer
- Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
- Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
- Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
- Crimes against women.

FINANCIAL BACKGROUND

- **Crorepati Sitting MLAs:** Out of **31** sitting MLAs analysed , **23 (74%)** are crorepatis.
- **Party wise crorepati Sitting MLAs:** **9 (82%)** out of **11** MLAs from **BJP**, **13 (68%)** out of **19** MLAs from **Sikkim Krantikari Morcha** and **1 (100%)** SDF MLA have declared assets valued more than **Rs 1 crore**.

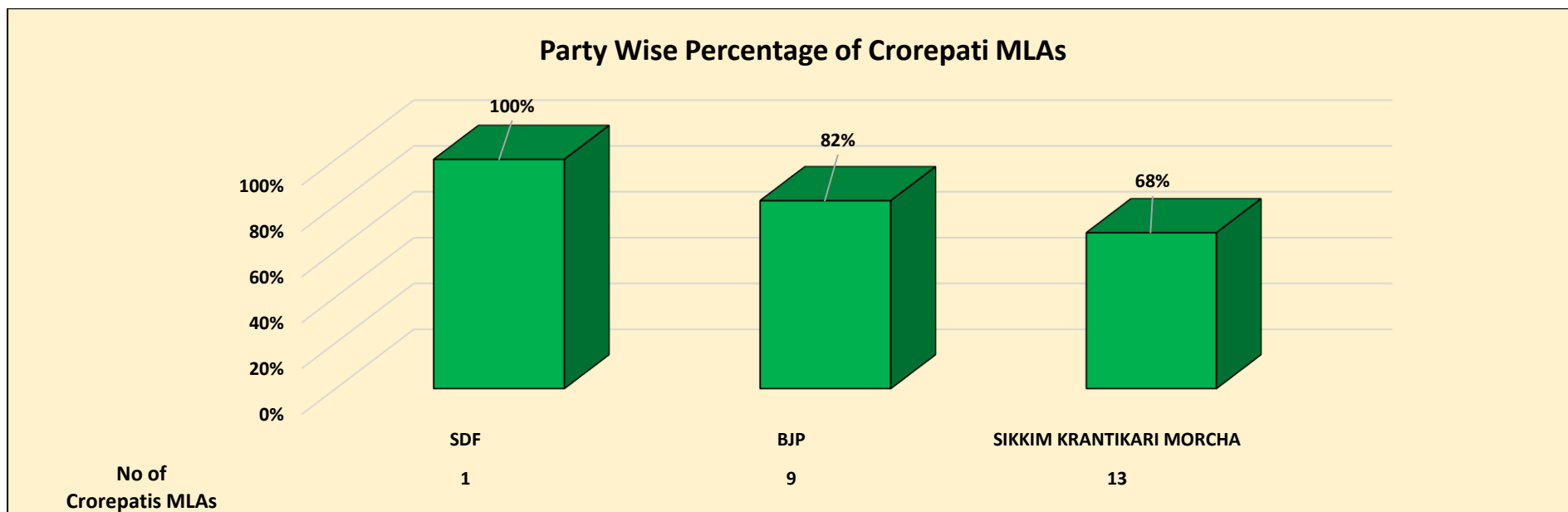


Figure: Party Wise Percentage of Crorepati MLAs

- **Average assets:** The average of assets per sitting MLA is **Rs.8.02 crore**.
- **Party wise average assets:** The average assets per MLA for **11 BJP** MLAs analysed is **Rs.11.45 crores**, **19 Sikkim Krantikari Morcha** MLAs analysed is **Rs.5.74 crores** and **1 SDF** MLA has average assets of **Rs.13.55 crores**.

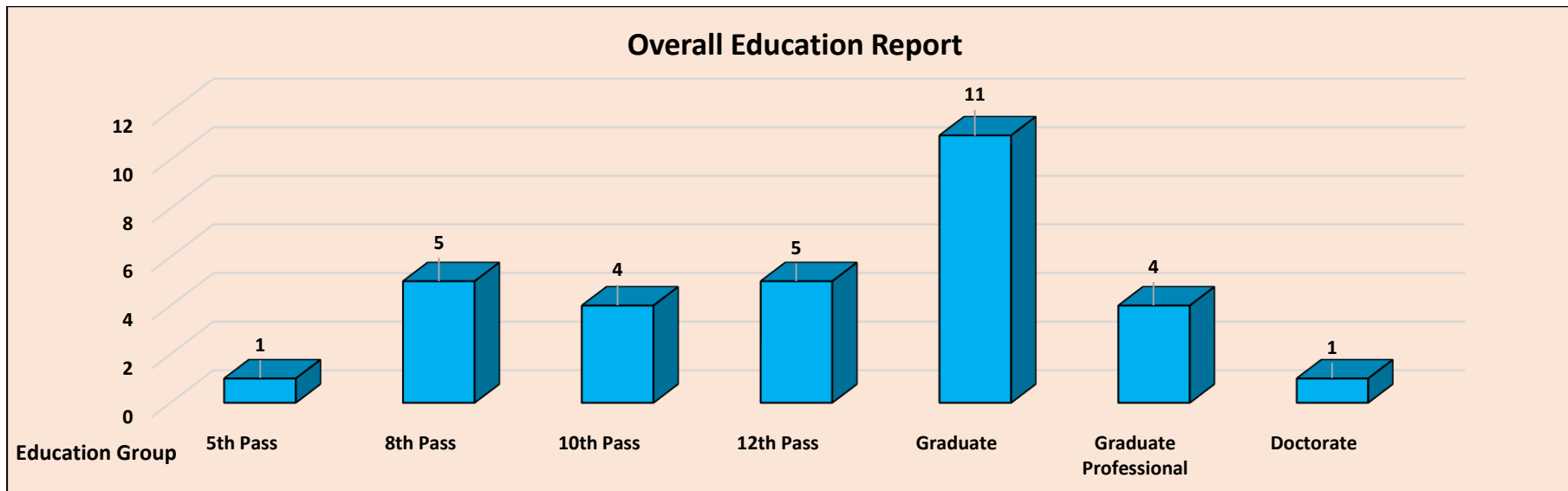


Figure: Analysis of MLAs on the basis of education

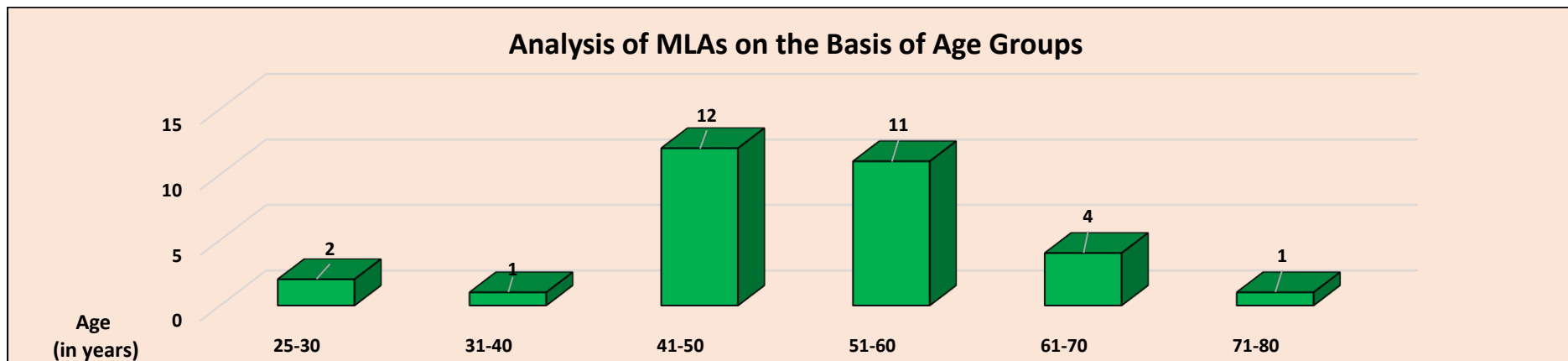


Figure: Analysis of MLAs on the basis of age groups

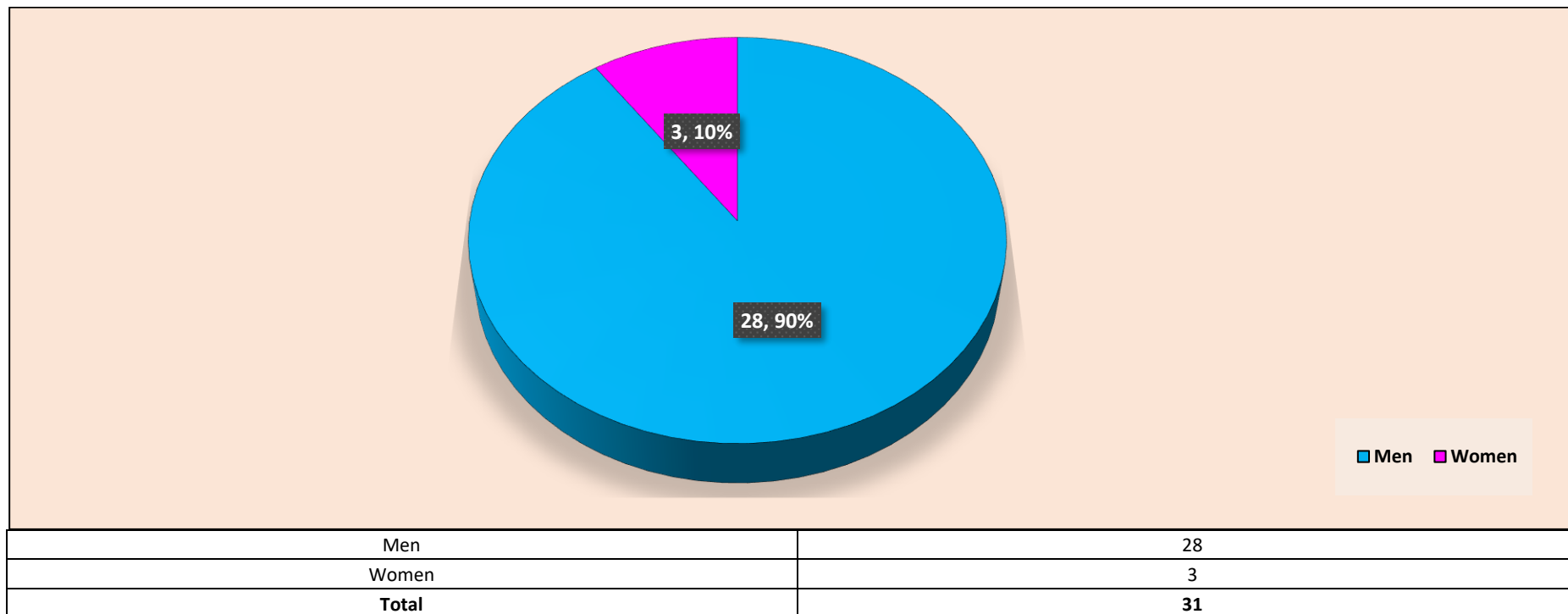
