Analysis of Margin of Victory and Representativeness of MLAs elected in 2009 Assembly Elections from Jharkhand

Association for Democratic Reforms and Jharkhand Election Watch have analysed the percentage of votes won by the MLAs of Jharkhand in assembly elections, 2009 and their representativeness among the total number of registered voters. The data disclosed by the Election Commission of India on their website (http://eci.nic.in/eci_main1/index.aspx) has been used for this report. **Voting percentage during this elections was 56.96%**

The percentage of representativeness was calculated by dividing the votes polled for the winner **by the electorate** i.e. the total number of registered voters. This value represents the percentage of votes won by the winning candidate among the total number of registered voters in the constituency.

$$\textbf{Representativeness} = \frac{\textit{Total Votes Polled for Winner}}{\textit{Total No. of Registered Voters}}$$

The percentage of vote share was calculated by dividing the votes polled for the winner **by the total number of valid votes**. This value represents the percentage of votes won by the winning candidate among the total number of valid votes polled.

$$\textbf{Vote Share} = \frac{\textit{Total Votes Polled for Winner}}{\textit{Total No. of Valid Votes Polled}}$$

Margin of victory for each winner in the Jharkhand Assembly elections, 2009 is calculated by dividing the difference between the votes polled for the winner and votes polled for the runners up by the total number of valid votes polled in the constituency

$$\textbf{Margin of Victory} = \frac{(\textit{Votes polled for Winner} - \textit{Votes polled for Runners up})}{\textit{Total No. of Valid Potes Polled}}$$






- **Average vote share of Winners:** The winners of the Jharkhand assembly elections, 2009 won by an average of 34% of total votes polled.
- **Vote Share of less than 50%:** 78 (96%) winners had won with less than 50% of total votes polled in their constituency.
- **Vote Share of less than 40%:** 63 (78%) Winners had won with less than 40% of total votes polled in their constituency.
- **Vote Share of less than 30%:** 21 (26%) winners had won with less than 30% of total votes polled in their constituency.
- **Vote Share of equal or more than 50%:** 3 winners (4%) won with vote share of equal or more than 50% of the votes polled in their constituency.

- **Party-wise vote share of less than 40%:** Out of 18 winners of BJP, 13 (72%) had won with less than 40% of total votes polled in their constituency. 14 (78%) out of 18 winners from JMM, 12 (86%) out of 14 winners from INC and 8 (73%) out of 11 winners from JVM won with less than 40% of total votes polled in their constituency.




- **Winners with highest vote share:** Chandreshwar Prasad Singh of BJP from Ranchi constituency had won with a vote share of 57% of total votes polled from his constituency. He was followed by Janardan Paswan of RJD from Chatra constituency with 51% of total votes polled and Raghubar Das of BJP from Jamshedpur constituency with 50% of total votes polled in the constituency.

None of the winners won with more than 34% votes of the total registered voters. This implies that none of the winners from Jharkhand Assembly elections 2009 represent more than 34% of the total electorate in their constituency



- ***Average representativeness of Winners:*** All the winners of the Jharkhand Assembly elections, 2009 won with an average of 20% votes of the total registered voters. This implies that the winners represent on an average, 20% of the total electorate.
- ***Winners with Representativeness of less than 30%:*** 78 (96%) winners had won with less than 30% votes of total registered voters in their constituency.


- **Winners with Representativeness of less than 20%:** 42 (52%) winners had won with less than 30% of total registered voters in their constituency.
- **Winners with Representativeness of more than 30%:** 3 (4%) candidates had won with more than 30% of total registered voters in their constituency.

- **Party-wise Representativeness of less than 30%:** Out of 18 winners of BJP, 17 (94%) had won with less than 30% votes of total registered voters in their constituency. 17 (94%) out of 18 winners from JMM, 14 (100%) out of 14 winners from INC and 10 (91%) out of 11 winners from JVP won with less than 30% votes of total registered voters in their constituency.


- **Average Margin of Victory for winners:** The winners in the Jharkhand Assembly elections, 2009 won with an **average margin of victory of 9%**
- **Margin of Victory less than 15%:** **67 (83%) winners** won with a margin of victory less than 15%.e, in 67 constituencies the margin of victory was less than 15%
- **Margin of Victory less than 10%:** **51 (63%) winners** won with a margin of victory less than 10%% i.e, in 51 constituencies the margin of victory was less than 10%
- **Margin of Victory less than 5%:** **27 (33%) winners** won with a margin of victory less than 5% i.e, in 27 constituencies the margin of victory was less than 5%

- **Party-wise Margin of Victory less than 5%:** Out of 18 winners of BJP, 8 (44%) had won with less than 5% margin of victory. 6 (33%) out of 18 winners from JMM, 6 (43%) out of 14 winners from INC and 2 (18%) out of 11 winners from JVP won with less than 5% margin of victory.
