Mizoram Election Watch* Lok Sabha elections 2009

Lok Sabha 2009 elections in Mizoram were held on April 16th 2009 for a single parliamentary constituency. This report includes analysis of voting trend, criminalization and money power in these elections.

Political Parties and Candidates

In Lok Sabha 2004, 2 parties contested. This remained unchanged for the Lok Sabha 2009 elections. In Lok Sabha 2004 elections 3 candidates contested. This went up to 4 candidates in Lok Sabha 2009 elections.

Executive summary

- Affidavits of all 4 candidates contesting the Lok Sabha 2009 elections were analyzed by the Mizoram Election Watch.
- None of these candidates had pending criminal cases.
- Average asset for a candidate from Mizoram was Rs. 39 lacs.
- The constituency was won by INC.
- The winner, C.L.Ruala had assets of approximately Rs. 54 lacs.
- None of the 4 contestants declared their PAN details.
- There were no female candidates in Mizoram.

The % of votes polled by major parties

INC managed to get 66% of the votes cast. This was 34% of the electorate. The total electorate in Mizoram was 6,29,384 and the total votes cast were 3,25,991.


